

Disease and Symptom Exclusion Recommendations

No exclusion necessary, keep shoes and socks on for all activities Diarrhea-free for 24 hours without the aid of medication; no vomiting for 24 hours
Daycare Only: Exclude until two negative stool cultures are obtained (must be 24 hours apart and 48 hours after discontinuation of antibiotics) School: Diarrhea-free for 24 hours without the aid of medication
No exclusion. If bacterial conjunctivitis, allowed to remain in school once any prescribed therapy is implemented
Fever-free for 24 hours without the aid of medication
Exclude until fever-free for 24 hours, no longer considered contagious once rash has appeared
Exclude until fever-free for 24 hours without the aid of medication and no open lesions
Exclude until treated for 24 hours with antibiotic; or physician note
Physician diagnosed: Excluded for 7 days following onset of illness or duration of illness if the case is immune-compromised
Exclude for 4 days after onset of rash; susceptible contacts that are not age appropriately vaccinated within 72 hours of first exposure shall be excluded for 21 days following the last exposure to an infectious case
If lesions can be covered, then no exclusion; if lesions cannot be covered, exclude until lesions have crusted over
Fever-free for 24 hours
Exclude for 5 days from onset of parotitis; susceptible contacts shall be excluded from day 12 to day 25 after exposure to an infectious case
Exclude until completion of appropriate antibiotic therapy (susceptible contacts no longer need to be excluded, only monitored)
No exclusion, practice good hand hygiene
Consider exclusion pending a physician evaluation
Exclude until after treatment has started; no activities involving skin-to-skin contact until lesions are completely healed.
Exclude for 7 days following onset of rash; susceptible contacts shall be excluded for 21 days following last exposure to a case
Exclude until after treatment with an approved anti-parasitic
Daycare Only: Exclude until one negative stool culture is obtained (collected 48 hours after discontinuation of antibiotics) School: Diarrhea-free for 24 hours without the aid of medication
If lesions can be covered, then no exclusion; if lesions cannot be covered, exclude until lesions have crusted over.
Exclude for 24 hours following initiation of antimicrobial therapy; if not receiving therapy exclude for 10 days following onset of symptoms
Exclude for 6 days or until all lesions have formed scabs or crusted over (whichever comes first); each susceptible contact not age appropriately vaccinated within 72 hours of first exposure shall be excluded for 21 days from the last exposure to an infectious case

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
